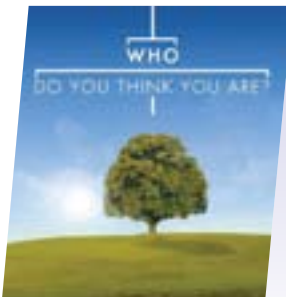

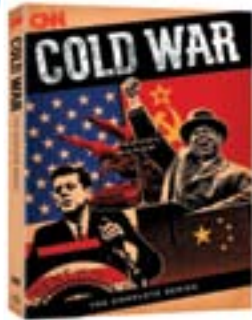

Education

Our Education Program offers classes and workshops for children and students grades K through 12 and workshops geared specifically for teachers. Using programs from the collection to illustrate and investigate, Paley Center Educators lead sessions on a wide range of subjects such as advertising, the documentary form, and the civil rights movement.



Collection

The foremost public archive of its kind, The Paley Center for Media's collection documents nearly ninety years of history and culture with close ties to media's cutting-edge creators, leaders, and innovators. With a focus on media preservation and archiving, the collection contains nearly 150,000 television and radio programs and advertisements, with selected video clips and commentary by our curators in both the New York and Los Angeles facilities.



Community

The Paley Center has established itself as a community gathering place for media conversations, becoming the communal living room for fan-based communities, a venue for documentary storytelling, and a platform for event television of all kinds. People have gathered in the Bannack Theater for our viewing parties ranging from the Royal Wedding of Prince William and Catherine Middleton to the World Cup Games in South Africa, as well as screenings from our partners at Philanthropy New York. Special events like TEDxWomen connect cities around the world for a one-day global conversation. Your support makes this community experience possible.
