For the safety and enjoyment of all, we ask that you please adhere to the following guidelines:

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Follow all instructions from the Paley Gaming Experts.
- Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult.
- The Virtual Reality (VR) Lab is limited to age 12+ for PlayStation® VR2 and age 13+
 for Meta Quest 2 (per manufacturer's requirements). All VR participants must sign a
 waiver indicating that they have read the VR health & safety warnings. Children under
 18 must have a parent/guardian present to sign the VR waiver.
- Visitors can reserve up to (4) Gaming Zones per day, with a limit of (1) 25-minute timeslot in each Zone. If there are empty timeslots, gamers may be permitted to play for longer at the Paley Gaming Expert's discretion.
- If you are not present (10) minutes after your start time, your reservation may be cancelled and the reserved console may be given to someone else.
- No more than 2 players may play on a console at once (except for the 85" TV Station, which has a max of 4 players).
- Please speak to a Paley Gaming Expert if you want to play a different game.
- Do not interfere with the gameplay of other guests.
- Do not sign in and play online with your personal account.
- Do not download games to Paley consoles or change any console settings.
- Do not damage equipment, throw controllers, or remove controllers from the gaming area.
- Inappropriate language or gestures, cheating, gambling, bullying, and taunting are prohibited.
- No food or drink in the PaleyGX Studio.
- Clear the game station when your session has ended and remove all your belongings.
