As always, Howland lends sterling comic support as ditzy, Gracie Allenesque Vera. (1983; 25 minutes) Alice: "86 the Waitresses" Alice, Flo, and Vera fight for women's rights when they learn that Mel is paying the new waiter twenty-five cents more per hour than they earn. 4:05	The Untouchables: "The Snowball" Smooth and ambitious Jackson Emmett Parker (Robert Redford) seeks mob backing for his bootleg liquor business.
